Tough Chianti Classico, but shows stuffing. Aromas of dried cherries, flowers and minerals. Medium-bodied, with fine tannins and a slightly austere finish. Better with a bit of age. Best from 2001 through 2004. 1,490 cases made.

WINE ENTHUSIAST

87 pts

Deep berry aromas accented by chocolate and multiple spices provide an inviting opening to this sturdy wine. The mouthfeel is full, and here the wine shows a much toastier, oak-driven profile than suggested by the bouquet. Lots of charcoal, licorice and earth flavors follow on the long, evenly tannic finish.
