### JAMES SUCKLING

#### 93-94 pts

A compact and savory young wine with blackberry, plum and hazelnut aromas and flavors. Medium to full body, firm tannins and a fresh finish

#### WINE ADVOCATE - Monica Larner

#### 94 pts

A blend of 95% Sangiovese and 5% Merlot, the 2019 La Gioia (with the red wax capsule in a rather heavy bottle) shows bramble and forest berry on first nose. It quickly shifts into a second gear that prizes richness and velvety softness. That added intensity appears to be driven by the small percentage of Merlot that does indeed change the overall DNA of the wine, giving it more density. La Gioia is a 7,000-bottle release.

#### VINOUS - ANTONIO GALLONI

#### **90 pts**

The 2018 TreSette, 100% Merlot, is not particularly distinguished, buti t does offer quite a bit of immediacy and appeal in a forward, mid-weight style that is easy to enjoy. This uncomplicated Merlot is nicely done.

#### WINE ENTHUSIAST

#### 92 pts

Violets, raspberries and passion fruit on the nose of this Tuscan Merlot join with savory notes of graphite, wet stone near a running stream, and black olives. Juicy fruit bursts through on the palate. Offering cherry, strawberry and raspberry.Firm if forgiving tannis strike a tension between powerful and graceful.
